<Character>	Stele	A bulky strand or cylinder of vascular tissue contained in stem and root of plants, developed from plerome	
<Character>	Root cap	A mass of hard cells covering the tip of a root and protecting it from mechanical injury	
<Character>	Phyllotaxy	The arrangement of leaves on a stem or branch is called phyllotaxy	
<Character>	Phellogen	The cork-cambium of tree stems arising as a secondary meristem and giving rise to cork and phelloderm	
	Dermatogen	The young or embryonic epidermis in plants
