The cave-temples of Pandyas in Tamil Nadu exhibit all varieties, both small and large.		
The shrine-front of the Pandya cave-temples are often flush with the hind wall of the <i>mandapa</i> or cut into projected shrine-fronts with <i>adhishthana</i> , pilaster and perhaps <i>kapota</i> -mouldings, partially anticipating the monolithic <i>rathas</i> in elevation.
